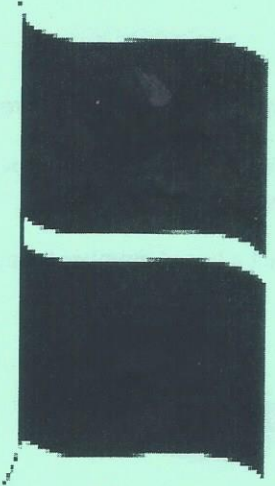
HURRICANE MATTHEW ROCKS "THE NUT"

Words from the President:

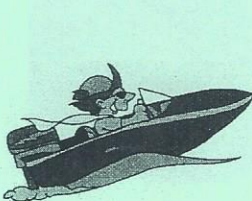
